<u>15 September 2017.</u> The new International School of Liquefied Natural Gas (LNG) is launched with its first course, which has been held yesterday and today in the Jovellanos Centre and the Enagás regasification plant in El Musel (Gijón).

The aim of the course, titled 'Safe Handling of LNG', is to teach students about the behaviour and routine handling of Liquefied Natural Gas. It has been delivered to 14 students from various professional sectors related to LNG, from plant supervisors to technicians from the emergency services.

The International School of LNG has been set up as a result of collaboration between the Maritime Safety Agency and Enagás. The main objective is to collaborate to offer training to professionals who work with LNG, both at a national and an international level.
