

## Enagás, acknowledged as the most sustainable Spanish company according to the Global 100 Index

- Enagás is ranked among the world's top 10 most sustainable companies
- The company stands as a world leader in the Gas Utilities sector

Enagás is the first Spanish company to appear in the 2017 Global 100 Most Sustainable Corporations in the World Index, presented today at the Davos Forum by the firm Corporate Knights, and is among the 10 most sustainable companies in the world. Furthermore, Enagás continues to be recognised as the world leader in the Gas Utilities sector of this index.

In compiling this ranking, Corporate Knights assessed all publicly traded companies with a market capitalisation of at least USD 2 billion and identified the 100 most sustainable businesses. To do so, they took into account 14 indicators related to the environment including innovation capacity, safety performance, human resources management and management salaries.

Enagás was also acknowledged as one of the 100 most sustainable companies, a worldwide leader in the Gas Utilities sector and the top Spanish company on the Index in 2013, 2015 and 2016.

This recognition reinforces the position of Enagás as a global leader in sustainability. It is worth noting that, among the company's main milestones in this area, it has kept its position on the Dow Jones Sustainability Index (DJSI) for the ninth consecutive year, and this week it renewed its place in the FTSE4Good index, where it has featured continuously since 2006.
